**SATURDAY SCHOOL** at Rockefeller Plaza (Sept. 14, 11 a.m.-3 p.m.). Don't let the title intimidate your kids: This free event promises no homework and plenty of fun. Devoted to entertaining explorations of STEAM (science, technology, engineering, the arts and math), this fair will host programs like <u>CodeScty</u>, which uses rap music and hip-hop videos to teach computer science; <u>KidCoolThereminSchool</u>, dedicated to hearing, playing and learning about that instrument; and <u>Art Sundae</u>, in which the author and artist Christopher Myers will engage children in drawing a "map" on the plaza that incorporates outlines of their bodies.
