The Queensland Art Gallery | Gallery of Modern Art (QAGOMA) Children's Art Centre and Regional Services are delighted to present Superpowered on Tour for children and families in regional and remote Queensland.

Superpowered on Tour has been developed to coincide with the Children's Art Centre exhibition 'Superpowered', on display at QAGOMA.

This program will feature activities created by the Children's Art Centre in collaboration with four Australian artists – Kaylene Whiskey (Yankunytjatjara people), Tony Albert (Girramay/Yidinyji/Kuku Yalanji peoples), Gordon Hookey (Waanyi people) and Vincent Namatjira (Western Aranda people) – who use their voices and their art to empower Aboriginal people and create inspirational imagery for all children. The activities will focus on strong empowering messages and humour.

Since 1998, the Gallery has collaborated with more than 300 Australian and international contemporary artists. The Children's Art Centre is a leader in developing interactive projects, activities and publications that engage children with contemporary cultures, artists and ideas.

The Kids on Tour program provides this content free of charge to communities throughout Queensland.
